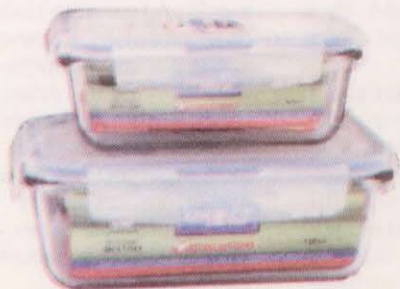

I'm a fan of these new containers made of borosilicate glass, which can withstand oven temperatures up to 400C (725F). The plastic lids are BPA-free, which means they are safe for storing and microwaving your favourite foods. The tight-fitting locking lids also mean goodbye to plastic wrap. My favourite is the 2L dish, which is large enough to hold a lasagna. You can bake the lasagna right in the dish, and snap the lid on any leftovers to keep them fresh for days. Smart.
